DATE AND PLACE OF CONTEST

August 9 – August 14, 2010, Ulaanbaatar, MONGOLIA

FLYING SITE LOCATION

Flying site – the field of “Darkhan Noyonii Khudag” approximately 50 km to the east from city of Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. You can see the flying field on internet by Google-earth software with the pointer 47°43'59.90" N, 107°23'34.17" E.

COMPETITION RULES

The competition will be organized according to the valid FAI Sporting Code, as well as all applicable amendments.

SPORTING LICENSES

Each competitor must process FAI Sporting License valid for 2010.

TIMEKEEPERS

Organizers will provide local timekeepers. Each participating country may enter a timekeeper and these timekeepers will be preferably used. The intention to enter a timekeepers should be announced in Entry Form. All these timekeepers should speak basic technical English.

The priority as for selecting timekeepers will be as follows:

- Competitors in F1A, F1B, F1C;
- Competitors in other classes;
- Everyone, who wants to be a timekeeper and has an experience.

Timekeepers will be provided with binoculars, stop-watches, chairs and umbrellas by us.

ENTRY FEE

Competitors – 50 EUR;

Juniors – 30 EUR;

Supporters, helpers, and spectators are free. 10 EUR in case they are interested in the gift package.

The entry fee covers participation in the Competition, trophies and gifts.

BANQUET

25 EUR – Place – the banquet hall the near from city of Ulaanbaatar. Transportation *to* and *from* will be provided.

PROTEST FEE

A protest may be submitted in accordance with the FAI Spording Code, Section 4, accompanied by a protest fee of 35 EUR, refundable if the protest is approved.

NATIONAL FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

Each country should bring their national flag (approximately 120×150 cm) and a CD or MP3 format with their national anthem to the Competition is requested. These will be returned before your departure.

ACCOMMODATION

Camping – free at the flying site.

The organizing committee will arrange hotel reservation, transportation service to the flying field from the hotel, and other related services for competitors, helpers, and supporters. TRAINING

Training is possible whole week before the start of the Competition, from August 2 to August 8, 2010. All interested countries and competitors must contact organizers to confirm their arrival for training.

VISA

Please check If visa is necessary to enter Mongolia from other countries. If you need any papers to support your visa, please let us know. The organizer may send letter of invitation to the 2010 Free Flight Mongolia Cup.

ELECTRICITY

For electrical appliances and charging equipments, electricity in Mongolia operates on 220 Volts (50 Hz).

RESPONSIBILITIES

All competitors shall be responsible for their own aeromodel crash and loss during the Competition. They are also responsible for their air flight, hotel and other trip expenses.

ANTI-DOPING

If a competitor has to take any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited list for a medical condition, then he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.
