




2013 FAI WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR FREE FLIGHT MODEL AIRCRAFT (SENIOR)

France (Moncontour-du-Poitou) – 3rd to 11th August 2013

The FAI World Championships for Free Flight Model Aircraft (classes F1A, F1B and F1C) for seniors will be organised at Moncontour-du-Poitou (86) on behalf of the French Federation of AeroModelling (FFAM) from 3rd August to 11th August 2013.



Moncontour is located in the department of Vienne on west of France.

Coming to Moncontour

From Paris: 350 km

From Bordeaux: 250 km

From Nantes: 140 km

Competition site A: GPS: 46°51'11" N, 00° 08'02" E

Participation

Every FAI affiliated National Airport Control Organisation (NAC) may enter a team consisting of :


- A Team Manager and an Assistant Team Manager.
- A maximum of three competitors in each class.
- Official helpers.

The individual 2011 F1A, F1B and F1C World Champions are also invited to participate. If the world champion is not a member of his national team, his score will not be considered for the team placing.

Each country's supporters are also invited to attend.

Flving site location

The proposed site **A** is located 13 km from Moncontour. This is where the 2004 Juniors World championships took place. The **B** site is 10 km distant. The **C** site, 15 km distant, could eventually be used in addition to A and B.



Competition Rules

According to the 2013 FAI Sporting Code Section 4 with applicable amendments for classes F1A, F1B and F1C.

FAI Sporting Licences

Every competitor, Team Manager and Assistant Team Manager must possess a valid and signed (by the holder) FAI Sporting Licence.

Identification Marks (Volume ABR paragraph B.17.6)

Each model aircraft shall carry:

- The national identification mark (nationality abbreviation of the International Olympic Committee) followed by the FAI licence number of the competitor. The letters and figures must be at least 25 mm high and appear at least one on each model.
- A model identification code (letters and/or numbers). This code has to be different for each nominated model aircraft of the competitor. The model identification code is to appear on each main part of the model (wing, tail, front and rear fuselage if detachable) so that the individual parts of the competitor's different models may be separately identified. The letters and/or numbers must be at least 10 mm high and clearly visible.
- The FAI model sticker as provided by the FAI.

Each NAC shall process every model aircraft and shall issue for each model aircraft a Model Aircraft Specification Certificate provided by the FAI.

Model aircraft not properly processed by their NAC, with FAI certificates and stickers, must be processed by the organiser at a cost of 8 Euro for each model.

Insurance

The Championship will be covered by limited third-party liability insurance covering all competitors for model accidents involving injury to others and damage to property. The organisers are not responsible for any other injury, loss, theft or damage to persons or property.

Individual health coverage as well as travel insurance purchased before arrival in France is recommended.

For EU citizens, health care is covered under Social Health Care on presentation of an EU 11 form available in the country of residence.

Anti-Doping Rules

If a competitor has to take, for a medical condition, any of the substances listed on the WADA Prohibited List, he must have a Therapeutic Use Exemption from the FAI.

Official languages

The official languages will be English and French.
